Grand palace & city temple & canal tour

Trip Description:

This tour combines three very popular Bangkok tours. The excursion includes Wat Trimit, the temple of the Golden Buddha - the statue of Buddha is made from solid gold weighting 5.5 tons; Wat Pho, the temple of the Reclining Buddha - the largest and oldest in Bangkok and the Grand Palace including Wat Phra Kaew-Temple of the Emerald Buddha. And sideseeing way of life in canal tour

ITINERARY

.....Meet your private English-speaking guide in the hotel's lobby. Depart from hotel to Rattanakosin Island, the original area of Bangkok when it was first established as the capital over 200 years ago. Visit Wat Trimit, known for its famous Golden Buddha. The beautiful image of solid gold is three meters high and weighs five and a half tons. Continue the tour by passing through beautiful city scenery of the colorful flower market and Chinatown. The bustling business area of Chinatown is especially known for its gold jewelry shops. The atmosphere is totally changed at night - hordes of food stalls line the streets. Visit Wat Pho or Temple of the Reclining Buddha, founded in the 16th century, the oldest and biggest temple with the largest number of pagodas (95 in all) in the city. Wat Pho was the first open university of Thailand which offered courses in several branches of knowledge like literature, astrology, medicine and massage. It's well known for its huge Reclining Buddha, 46 m. long and 15 m. high.

..... Visit The Grand Palace has an area of 218,400 sq. metres and is surrounded by walls built in 1782. The length of the four walls is 1,900 meters. Within these walls are situated government offices and the Chapel Royal of the Emerald Buddha besides the royal residences. Wat Phra Kaeo, the most beautiful and important Buddhist temple in Thailand. It is so richly and intricately decorated that, once entering the temple, you will feel as if you are in a real "city of angels".

.....Cruise in a comfortable long-tail motor boat along the Chao Phraya River and canals in Thonburi area. You will be treated to spectacular and colorful scenery of Thai life along the river banks. The Bangkok people still depend on the waterways to transport their merchandise. En route you can see many magnificent temples and architectural buildings, including Grand Palace, Wat Arun or The Temple of Dawn, the Royal Thai Navy Dockyard, the Thai Maritime Navigation Company, the Old Customs House and Royal Barges Museum.

.....City-sightseeing tour along Ratchadumnoen Rd. (The Royal's Way). En route you can see many magnificent temples and architectural buildings, including the City Pillar Shrine, National Museum, Democracy Monument, Golden Mountain, Thai Boxing Stadium, Anantasamakhom Palace, Parliament House, Dusit Zoo and Chitlada Palace King's Residence. Arrive your hotel.

.....See the Greatest Elephant Show in Thailand, an elephant show complete with dramatic sounds and narration Watch a ceremonial rite to bless the buffalo hide cord before hunting the elephants. ..... Rose Garden, Enjoy the unique and unforgettable experience of the world-renowned Thai Village Cultural Show. Over 150 performers vividly portray a fascinating cross-section of Thailand's culture, heritage and way of life -- dances, ceremonies, rituals, sports and pastimes.

Summer palace & city temple in Ayuttaya

ITINERARY

..... Meet your private English-speaking guide in the hotel's lobby. Depart from hotel to Ayuttaya

.....visit Bang Pa-In Palace is not situated in Ayutthaya city proper, but is well worth making an effort to get to see. The palace comprises a collection of buildings of various ages and various architectural styles surrounded by a lake. Originally built by King Prasattong, Bang Pa-In was the residence of all the kings in the Ayutthaya period but it was left unoccupied when Bangkok became the capital. Its importance was reestablished in 1851 when King Mongkut restored the palace and monarchs resumed residing there. Bang Pa-In Palace compound houses a number of important buildings. The public can only go inside two of these buildings: Phra Thinang Wehat Chamrun - a Chinese-style building intended for use during rainy seasons – and Phra Thinang Withun Thatsana - a tower-like 'observatory' with a number of balconies to take in good views of the palace's gardens. Other buildings worthy of note include Phra Thinang Aisawan Thippa – a pavilion standing in the middle of the lake - and Phra Thinang Warophat Phiman – a two-storey building that housed King Mongkut's apartments and reception hall.

..... Launch at.....

.....visit Wat Phra Si Sanphet is the loveliest and historically most important temple in old Ayutthaya. Its three large chedis and numerous smaller ones on a long terrace make this wat - also known as the King's Temple - one of the most impressive sights in the ruined city. **Next to the old palace** Phra Mongkhon Bophit is one of the largest bronze Buddha images in Thailand the image measures 9.55 meters at the widest point across the lap, and 12.45 meters high without the base. Believed to have been constructed in the early Ayutthaya period between 1448 to 1602 AD. Originally situated at the east side of the old palace compound

.....visit Wat Mahathat was begun during the reign of King Borommarachathirat 1 in 1374 A.D. but it was completed during the reign of King Ramesuan (1388-1396 A.D.). When King Songtham (1680-1628 A.D.) was in power the main prang (Khmer- style tower) collapsed. The restoration work on the prang was probably completed in the reign of King Prasartthong (1630- 1655 A.D.). During the restoration the height of the prang was considerably increased. Wat Mahathat was restored once again during the reign of King Borommakot (1732-1758 A.D.) when four porticos of the main prang were added. In 1767 A.D. when Ayutthaya was sacked the wat was burnt and has since then been in ruins.

.....Depart from Ayuttaya back to Bangkok
